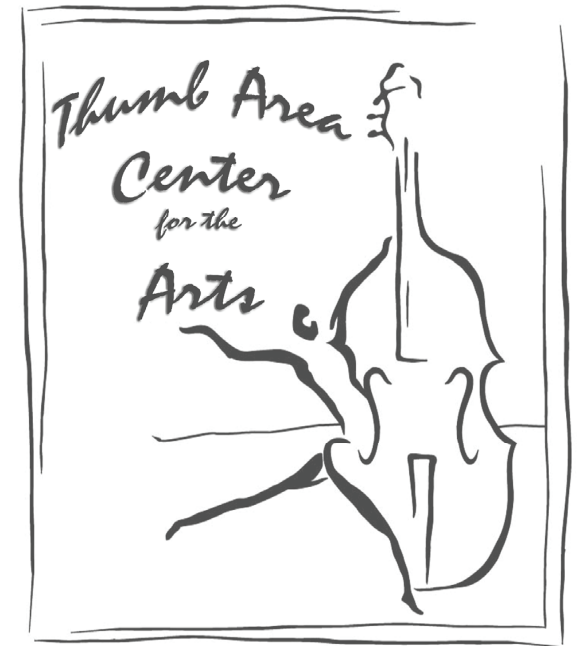

Founded in 1976 and formerly known as the Caro Arts Society, Thumb Area Center for the Arts (TACA) is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) arts organization dedicated to serving the Thumb area by providing our communities with enriching arts experiences. The following is a brief overview of just some of TACA's contributions to area arts engagement:

PERFORMING ARTS

MUSIC

The Annual Community Christmas Concert (first Monday in December), The Young Americans in partnership with Caro Community Schools, acapella concerts, and Broadway revues top the list of offerings TACA has spearheaded in our community.

THEATER

Since 1976, TACA has produced at least two community theater shows each year, most as dinner theater productions in partnership with the Caro Knights of Columbus. In 2011, TACA became the umbrella organization for Theater After Dark, which has dazzled multiple audiences with interactive presentations of Richard O'Brien's "The Rocky Horror Show."

VISUAL ARTS

Art classes and workshops for both children and adults taught by regionally and nationally renowned artists accompany the annual Student Celebration, in cooperation with Caro Schools PTO, which showcases the youth art created in school.
